

LAURIE MCBRIDE SCHOLARSHIP

Application Deadline is May 11, 2018

The Laurie McBride Scholarship offers a **full scholarship** equal to \$7,200 for the 2018-19 academic year to a qualified junior or senior open to all majors. The scholarship is named for long-time LGBTQ lobbyist and activist Laurie McBride. Laurie was a leading advocate and instrumental in pushing for protections for the LGBTQ community.

The scholarship named in honor of Laurie McBride is funded by the Stonewall Foundation of Greater Sacramento and it is their goal to cultivate new advocates who understand that fighting for equality requires ongoing commitment and resolve.

Award: One full scholarship of \$7,200 for the 2018-19 academic year

Criteria: Students in their junior or senior year. Open to all majors

Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better

Required to submit an essay of 500 - 1,000 words in length. Essay should describe how you have supported LGBTQ rights in the community and how you plan to continue to serve and advance the LGBTQ equity.

Applications with an attached letter of support from an on campus or community agency engaged in LGBTQ advocacy will be viewed favorably.
